6. Share any favorite pieces of poetry in the *Song of Songs* and why they stand out for you.

7. What kind of message or learning will you take from having studied the *Song of Songs*?

8. If it had been up to you, would *Song of Songs* have been included or excluded from the Bible? Why?

9. What are the implications of this session's material for your personal life? Your spiritual journey? For your local faith community?
